

Danish for German Speakers at IA Sprog (Level 1&2)

FAQ

What?

Our Danish for German speakers covers both level 1 and 2 in just 12 weeks, after which you'll do a test at A2 level.

When?

Classes are held once a week

Evening classes	17.30-20.00
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Why choose a Danish for German Speakers program?

Due to the many similarities between Danish and German when it comes to both grammatical structures and vocabulary, German speakers tend to progress faster than most others when learning Danish. Grammatical sentence structures fall into place somewhat automatically or subconsciously, and vocabulary is easily acquired with the help of dictionaries and similar phrases in German. This leaves us free to focus more on pronunciation and we will quickly be able to move on to freer forms of conversation and writing, focusing on theme-related language.

Which language is used in class?

Well, mainly Danish off course :) But in the first couple of levels we'll use a bit of English as instruction language which is why English language skills as well as knowledge of English grammar terms are required.

Furthermore, your teacher will have a structural knowledge of German and will thus draw attention to the many similarities vis-à-vis Danish.

How much is the fee?

The fee is 1500 DKK - this fee covers 12 weeks of classes, learning material, and a test.

How about payment?

You can pay online or via Mobile Pay.

Which material do we use?

Our own learning material (**Skolegade, I gang, and Dansk..selvfølgelig!**) has been developed and tested by experienced language teachers and researchers here at IA Sprog and consists of text books as well as a wealth of e-learning material available at mit.iasprog (Our LMS).

How much homework should I expect?

You should expect around 4 hours of homework/self-study per week.

How about attendance?

To ensure your full benefit of the course we expect an 85% attendance in class. If you get sick or for some other reason are prevented from attending class, please inform your teacher in advance and do the extra homework for your following class.

Which tests will we do?

We've developed our own tests according to the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference) at levels A1, A2, A2/B1, and B1.

You'll receive a certificate when you pass one of these tests.

Who can continue to the following level?

If you pass your tests, you're more than welcome to join the following level here at IA Sprog.

What happens if I don't pass the test?

If you don't pass the whole test the first time your teacher will evaluate your specific situation.

Depending on whether you pass most of the test or nothing at all it will be decided if we recommend that you simply do a re-test or repeat the whole, or part of the level.

How about the final exam - the PD3?

We can teach you from level 1 and all the way to the final level, i.e. level 5 and we can even help you prepare for the final exam (PD3) but you'll have to sign up for the exam itself at one of the public schools. You'll pay a fee of 1335 DKR (in 2019) just to attend the PD3 exam itself at a public school.
