

Flexible Danish Classes at IA Sprog

(Level 1, 2, and 3)

FAQ

What?

Our Flexible Program covers one whole level in just 12 weeks after which you'll do a test.

When?

Classes are held once a week

Evening classes	17.30-20.00
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How much is the fee?

Level 1-3

The fee is 2160 DKK - this fee covers 12 weeks of classes, access to learning material, and a test.

Level 4-5

The fee is 2610 DKK - this fee covers 15 weeks of classes, access to learning material, and a test.

How about payment?

Which method is used?

Our Flexible Danish Course is a Blended Learning program which means that there is a natural flow between classroom and e-learning activities.

In class there will be a strong focus on oral communicative skills, including pronunciation.

Outside class, you will also practice your oral Danish through assignments. Furthermore, you'll be able to practice listening, reading and writing – and do grammar exercises through our e-learning platform.

Which material do we use?

Our brand new learning material **Dansk ... selvfølgelig!** which we use in level 1 and 2, has been developed and tested by experienced language teachers and researchers here at IA Sprog. It consists of text books as well as a wealth of e-learning material available at mit.iasprog (Our LMS). The focus of this material is the need of Danish in everyday situations that demand your active participation. In level 3 we also use our own material **I gang** along with the e-learning platform. In level 4 and 5 we use various learning material, mostly books which you can borrow at the school. etc.

How much homework should I expect?

You should expect around 3-4 hours of homework/self-study per week – some online, some alone, and some through our e-learning platform.

How about attendance?

To ensure your full benefit of the course we suggest an 85% attendance in class. If you get sick or for some other reason are prevented from attending class, please inform your teacher in advance and do the extra homework for your following class.

Which language is used in class?

Well, Danish off course :) But in the first couple of levels we'll use quite a bit of English as instruction language which is why English language skills as well as knowledge of English grammar terms are required.

Which tests will we do?

We've developed our own tests according to the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference) at levels A1, A2, A2/B1, and B1. You'll receive a certificate when you pass one of these tests. Please note that our certificate is **not** the official Modultestbevis.

Who can continue to the following level?

If you pass your tests, you're more than welcome to join the following level here at IA Sprog.

What happens if I don't pass the test?

If you don't pass the whole test the first time your teacher will evaluate your specific situation. Depending on whether you pass most of the test or nothing at all it will be decided if we recommend you to simply do a re-test or repeat the whole, or part of the level.

How about the final exam - the PD3?

We can teach you from level 1 and all the way to the final level, i.e. level 5 and we can even help you prepare for the final exam (PD3) but you'll have to sign up for the exam itself at one of the public schools. You'll pay a fee of 1362 DKR (in 2019) just to attend the PD3 exam itself at a public school.
